MOPC Public Works & Development / Emergency Services – Summer Positions

The Municipality of Pictou County is currently accepting applications for the following summer employment opportunities in our Public Works and Development Department:

Engineering Summer Student:

This role will be to assist the public works and development department in support of special engineering-related projects. Work to be completed will vary and will exercise education gained from an engineering, environmental sciences, technology, or other related program (university P.Eng. track, university sciences, or similar). Specific tasks are expected to include assistance in the preparation of the water and sewer system modelling in Autodesk Civil 3D, design and preparation of Municipal standard specifications, construction inspection, capital project execution, water system modelling, preparation and implementation of MOPC's asset management initiatives, and preparation of environmental reports related to the MOPC's water and sewer infrastructure, among other duties as required by the Director of Public Works & Development.

Public Works Summer Student:

This role will be to assist the public works group and emergency services department with special projects and functions normally completed during summer months. This will exercise education gained from mechanical, EMT, or technology secondary education program (college). Tasks to be completed during the time of employment will include servicing and assessing flow conditions for municipal hydrants, development and execution of a program for the cleaning, reviewing, and making improvements to sewage lift stations, and projects to improve aesthetics of municipal properties, among other duties as required by the Director of Public Works & Development. They will also include cosmetic maintenance of hydrants, fire hydrant testing, and valve exercising, among other duties as assigned. General labour will be required as part of this role, including, but not limited to, maintenance of Municipality grounds (mowing, trimming, and removal of vegetation), minor repairs to existing Municipality assets (gravels, etc.), and other physical work.

Remuneration:

Based on hourly rate (\$19.70 per /hour) per MOPC's Summer Employment Policy (35 hours per week).

Employment Duration:

12-14 Week Term – Start and End Dates Negotiable Between May and August
