To begin, you must have a separate payee for each; taxes and water.

Property Taxes

Go to "Add Payee" Search "Pictou" Select "Pictou County Taxes" Add all 8 digits of your Municipal Account number

Water Utility

Go to "Add Payee" Search "Pictou" Select "Pictou County Water" Add all 8 digits of your Municipal Account number

You can also pay your property tax bills by dropping a cheque into the mail.

Citizen Appointments

The Municipality of the County of Pictou currently has vacancies for the following volunteer positions:

Municipal Audit Committee (1 position)

Two Year Term, ending March 2027.

The Committee is responsible for reviewing the qualifications, independence, quality of service and performance of External Auditors, and to recommend to Council the appointment or discharge of External Auditors. The Committee is also responsible for reviewing the financial statements of the Municipality evaluating internal control systems and management letters and carrying out all responsibilities as outline in Section 44(2) of the Municipal Government Act. Applicants must demonstrate a strong financial background and knowledge of accounting practices and audit routine. The Committee will meet 4 times annually.

Riverton Guest Home Corporation Board of Directors (1 position)

Two Year term, ending March 2027.

The Board is responsible for the management & operation of Valley View Villa.

Residents of the Municipality interested in these positions should submit a letter of application electronically to <u>sueann.musick@munpict.ca</u> no later than 12:00 Noon on Wednesday, July 3, 2025. To be considered eligible for consideration, applicants must be a resident of the Municipality and must have lived in the Municipality for a minimum of six (6) months. Applications should include a brief biography which details any previous or related experience and skills that would be an asset to these positions and must supply 3 professional and/or volunteer-related references. These positions require a flexible work schedule to accommodate both daytime and/or evening meetings.
