## **MOPC Alert**



MOPC Alert was created as a tool for the Municipality to connect with residents to send important information prior to, during and after adverse weather events, or other EMO related information.

MOPC Alert is used to send our residents alerts about upcoming severe weather, comfort center locations and operating times, as well as any other information residents should be aware of such as public hearings or public engagement sessions.

Imagine MOPC is a project to develop a Municipal Planning Strategy (MPS) and Land Use Bylaw (LUB) for the Municipality of Pictou County.

Currently, there is no land use planning in MOPC with the exception of the Wind Energy Bylaw and the Subdivision Bylaw. In 2018, the Provincial Government passed new legislation that requires every municipality to adopt land use rules that meet newly established minimum planning standards. 
The goal of the Switch MOPC Program is to make home energy upgrades simple and financially accessible. Participants receive support from a personal Energy Concierge, who guides them through every step—helping with contractor selection, project planning, and navigating the financing process to ensure a smooth experience. The program offers financing to remove the barrier of upfront costs. The program pays contractors directly, allowing homeowners to repay through small monthly payments over 10-15 years. ## **BurnSafe 101**

The BurnSafe map is your guide to when it's safe to burn in Nova Scotia during wildfire season, March 15 to October 15.



Burning is never allowed from 8 am to 2 pm during wildfire season because that is often when the risk of wildfires is greatest. The map is RED during those hours. After 2 pm, check for an update.

Burn restrictions are updated daily at 2 pm based on weather data.



Check online at NovaScotia.ca/BurnSafe or call 1-855-564-2876 to see if burning is allowed.

You could be fined \$25,000 if you do not follow Provincial restrictions
