2018/19 FINANCIAL STATEMENTS (6:35 P.M.)

Ms. Heather Murphy, MacDonald & Murphy Inc. reviewed the Consolidated Financial Statements for the Municipality for the period ending March 31, 2019. In respect to the report Ms. Murphy advised it is the opinion of the firm that the financial statements present fairly, in all material respects, the financial position of the Municipality and the results of its operations and cash flows.

In reviewing the Consolidated Statements of Financial Activities, Ms. Murphy reported that the total revenue for the reporting period was \$19,925,992; total expenditures for the period were \$15,925,992 and the change in the fund balances for the year was \$3,542,039.
