**Climate Change Advisory Committee**

The Committee is responsible to advise Municipal Council, Administration & Consultant/Project Management Team on specific matters as they pertain to the Municipality's Climate Change Adaptation Plan by fostering and promoting environmental and climate change awareness, partnerships within the community, and community engagement.

The objectives of the committee are to develop a climate adaptation vision for the Municipality, advise on a public consultation process, provide education & outreach support through community events, and to focus on other initiatives as identified by the Committee and approved by Council. The Committee will plan & organize events & activities for stewardship, education & outreach, liaise with other environmental advisory committees/groups/organizations, and coordinate events with other environmental groups where possible. The Committee will also be responsible to review and comment to Council on environmentally related plans, bylaws, development proposals and studies, and to provide comment and opinion when called upon by Council regarding any matters referred to the Committee.

Residents of the Municipality interested in serving in this volunteer capacity should submit a letter of application to [applications@munpict.ca](mailto:applications@munpict.ca) by March 12, 2020. To be considered eligible for consideration, applicants must be a resident of the Municipality and must have lived in the Municipality for a minimum of six (6) months. Applications should include a brief biography which details any previous or related experience and skills that would be an asset to this position and must supply 3 professional and/or volunteer related references.
